	Improvement	DEV-805	New Activation's Files Folder support to streamline any setup or configurations changes to be made to your workspace

	Bug Fix	DEV-774	Announcements should no longer overlap the lobby display template when they are too long.

	Bug Fix	DEV-831	The "Save & New" button for packages is now functioning correctly.
